Subject: RoHS European Directives 2002/95/EU, 2011/65/EU and 2015/863/EU

The RoHS European Directives 2002/95/EU, 2011/65/EU and 2015/863/EU is a directive on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

Transfer Oil products are in accordance with the requirement of the RoHS directives and their amendments. Transfer Oil products do not contain the listed hazardous substances, within the given limitations, with the exception of steel alloy (maximum 0.35% Pb) and copper alloy (maximum 0.4% Pb) metal machined parts where Lead concentrations are above 0.1%. However, these meet the exemption requirements according to RoHS Annex III Lead exemptions, Exemption 6a and Exemption 6c as specified in Article 4 paragraph 6.

This information is based on data provided by our suppliers. Transfer Oil does not perform tests or analysis for SVHC on raw materials used in its manufacturing process or finished product.
